

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

A WARNING

Do not exceed GVWR or GAWR, including blade and ballast. The rating label is found on the driver-side vehicle door cornerpost.

Blade can drop unexpectedly. Place blade on jack stands. Failure to do so could result in serious personal injury.


- Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Raise the blade, then turn the control OFF.
- 2. From the side of the blade assembly, place jack stands under the T-frame.
- Turn the control ON and lower the blade onto the jack stands. Turn the control OFF. Turn the vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position and remove the key.

XV2™ and XLS™ Snowplows with Three Holes in the Base Angle


1. Align the shoe bracket holes with the holes in the base angle.

NOTE: All three holes in the bracket must line up with the three holes in the base angle.

2. Insert a 5/8" x 2" cap screw down through each of the two outer holes in the base angle and shoe bracket. Attach 5/8" locknuts and tighten to 150 ft-lb.



- 3. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 4. Place flat washers on the shoe and insert the shoe up through the center hole in the shoe bracket and base angle. Secure with a linchpin.




- 5. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 6. Turn the vehicle ignition and snowplow control ON. Raise the blade slightly. Turn the control OFF and remove the jack stands.
- 7. Stand 8 feet clear of the blade, and lower the blade to the ground.

XtremeV™ Snowplows with One Hole in the Base Angle


(9.5' XtremeV base angle shown.)

 Align the innermost hole in the shoe bracket with the existing hole in the base angle. Insert a 5/8" x 2" cap screw down through the hole in the base angle and shoe bracket. Attach a 5/8" locknut and hand tighten.


NOTE: The narrowest edge of the bracket must be facing away from the base angle.




2. Align the edge of the shoe bracket with the edge of the base angle and clamp in place. Using the holes in the bracket as a guide, drill one 1-1/16" hole and one 11/16" hole in the base angle, as shown below.



3. Insert a 5/8" x 2" cap screw down through the outermost hole in the base angle and the shoe bracket. Attach a 5/8" locknut and tighten both fasteners to 150 ft-lb.



- 4. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 5. Place flat washers on the shoe and insert the shoe up through the center hole in the shoe bracket and base angle. Secure with a linchpin.



- 6. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 7. Turn the vehicle ignition and snowplow control ON. Raise the blade slightly. Turn the control OFF and remove the jack stands.
- 8. Stand 8 feet clear of the blade, and lower the blade to the ground.

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
