FORD MOTOR COMPANY DISCONTINUED THEIR BRONCO II/RANGER PACKAGE FOR A SNOWPLOW APPLICATION ON THESE 1989 MODELS. CONSEQUENTLY, THEIR OWNER'S MANUALS NOW STATE THAT THESE VEHICLES ARE NOT RECOMMENDED FOR PLOWING SNOW. HOWEVER, WITH THE ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONS LISTED BELOW, FISHER ENGINEERING BELIEVES THESE TWO MODELS WILL BE FUNCTIONAL, RELIABLE AND SAFE.

VEHICLE APPLICATION PRECAUTIONS

- 1. RESTRICTED TO 6-1/2 FOOT HS BLADE.
- 2. FRONT AIR BAGS REQUIRED FOR SNOW PLOWING.

AIR PRESSURE: SUMMER 20-25 PSI WINTER 35-40 PSI

- 3. APPROVED ONLY FOR NON-COMMERCIAL PLOWING.
- 4. WEIGHT ON FRONT AXLE MUST NOT EXCEED 63% OF LOADED VEHICLE WEIGHT. RECOMMENDED COUNTERWEIGHT: 150 lbs. SECURELY FASTEN COUNTERWEIGHT WELL BEHIND REAR AXLE. DO NOT EXCEED GVW RATING.
- A. REMOVE AIR DAM FROM FRONT OF TRUCK. INSTALL AIR BAGS PER INSTRUCTIONS IN AIR BAG KIT (24).
- B. INSTALL THE DRIVER'S SIDE PUSHPLATE (1) TO THE DRIVER'S SIDE FRAME RAIL AND FASTEN WITH A 1/2 X 1-1/2 GR. 5 CAPSCREW (8) PLACED DOWN THROUGH A HEAVY SQUARE WASHER (19), THE BOTTOM FRAME FLANGE AND THE AFT HOLE OF THE HORIZONTAL PAD ON THE PUSHPLATE. FASTEN WITH A 1/2 LOCKWASHER (10) AND NUT (9) BUT DO NOT TIGHTEN. INSTALL ONE 7/16 X 1-1/2 (NC) GR. 5 CAPSCREW (20) WITH ANOTHER HEAVY SQUARE WASHER (19) DOWN THROUGH THE FRAME AND THE FORWARD HOLE IN THE PUSHPLATE. FASTEN WITH A 7/16 LOCKWASHER (21) AND NUT (22). INSTALL TWO 5/8 X 1-1/2 (NC) CAPSCREWS (11) WITH FLATWASHERS (23) OUT THROUGH THE FRAME AND THE VERTICAL PORTION OF THE PUSHPLATE (LOWER HOLE MAY NEED TO BE REAMED). FASTEN WITH 5/8 LOCKWASHERS (13) AND NUTS (12). INSTALL THE PASSENGER'S SIDE PUSHPLATE (2) IN THE SAME MANNER.
- C. ASSEMBLE CONNECTING PINS (15) TO PUSHBEAM (3). FIRST INSERT SPRINGS (17) BETWEEN TWO INNER EARS ON EACH SIDE OF PUSHBEAM. THEN, INSERT CONNECTING PIN (16) THROUGH ALL THREE EARS WITH HANDLE OF PIN TOWARDS THE CENTER OF THE BEAM. LEAVING THE HOLE IN THE PIN BETWEEN THE INNER TWO EARS, PULL BACK ON SPRING AND INSTALL COTTER PIN (18).

- INSTALL THE PUSHBEAM (3) BETWEEN THE PUSHPLATES. SECURE WITH TWO 1/2 X 1-1/4 CAPSCREWS (7), TWO 1/2 X 1-1/2 GR. 5 CAPSCREWS (8), D. FOUR 1/2" LOCKWASHERS (10) AND NUTS (9). DO NOT TIGHTEN.
- INSTALL THE HEADGEAR (SEE COMMON INSTRUCTIONS) AND HEADGEAR BRACES (4) TO THE PUSHPLATES USING SIX 1/2 X 1-1/4 CAPSCREWS (7), E. LOCKWASHERS (9) AND NUTS (10).
- AFTER ALL PARTS AND FASTENERS ARE IN PLACE, TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS F. IN THE ORDER IN WHICH THEY WERE INSTALLED.
- TO REINSTALL AIR DAM, NOTCH OR CUT INTO THREE SECTIONS AS SHOWN G. BELOW:
