


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

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


#### **A** WARNING

Blade can drop unexpectedly. Place blade on jack stands. Failure to do so could result in serious personal injury.

- 1. Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Raise the blade, then turn the control OFF.
- 2. From the side of the blade assembly, place jack stands under the T-frame.
- Turn the control ON and lower the blade onto the jack stands. Turn the control OFF. Turn the vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position and remove the key.
- 4. Remove the two outermost cutting edge bolts from the driver-side blade wing.
- 5. Place the driver-side shoe bracket against the blade wing, aligning the bracket holes with the outermost cutting edge mounting holes. Install the bracket using two supplied 5/8" x 2-1/2" carriage bolts, two 5/8" flat washers, and two 5/8" locknuts.



- 6. Tighten the fasteners to 150 ft-lb.
- 7. Repeat Steps 4–6 for the passenger's side.
- 8. Insert the stem of one shoe up through the shoe bracket and adjust it to the desired height. Secure the shoe using a 3/8" x 2-3/4" pin with handle and a hairpin cotter.



- 9. Repeat Step 8 for the opposite blade wing.
- 10. Turn the vehicle ignition and snowplow control ON. Raise the blade slightly. Turn the control OFF and remove the jack stands.
- 11. Stand 8 feet clear of the blade, and lower the blade to the ground.

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
