


Installation Instructions

- 1. Place the deflector on a table or workbench and drive the eight 5/16" x1" carriage bolts into the holes in the deflector. This will allow the carriage bolts to grip in the deflector. Make sure that all carriage bolts are pointing the same direction.
- Place the adjustment rod on the back side of the deflector as shown and secure with one rod clamp and two 5/16" external tooth lock washers and two 5/16" nuts. Repeat this step for the other side of the deflector.



 Place the assembled deflector on the spreader behind the spinner. The carriage bolts should be pointing toward the truck. Secure the deflector to the deflector plate with four 5/16" external tooth lock washers and four 5/16" nuts. 4. Remove the cap screws that secure the throat clamp to the spreader frame. Reinstall the throat clamp with the adjustment hoop over it as shown.



5. Insert the adjustment rods into the desired holes on the adjustment hoop and secure with the supplied hairpin cotters.
